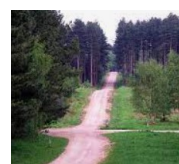

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Reminders

English

Story writing linked to Eddie's Garden, Oliver's Vegetables, Jack and the Jelly Beanstalk, The Three Little Wolves, Billy and the Beast and writing about our visit to Sherwood Pines.

Music/Art

Explore ways to make loud and soft sounds (dynamics) and use long and short sounds. Sketching nature; printing; weaving materials in the style Jessica Nielsen.

Computing

This term we will be using laptops. We will learn to recognise the keys on a keyboard, enter text and change the font.

Maths

We will be learning about multiplication and division; fractions; position and direction; place value to 100; also money and time.



Year 1

DT

This term children will create a funny face salad! They will each design with a purpose, make, evaluate... and eat their delicious and healthy creations!

History / Geography

Investigation of significant events, places and historical figures from Nottingham—Robin Hood! Investigation of maps, create 3D floor maps adding simple compass directions and a key.

Science

We will look at the structure of a plant and identify some common garden plants and trees. We will investigate these as we go on a plant hunt at Wolaton Park.

RE / RHSE

In RE we are learning about Sikhism and we will compare Sikhism to Islam, In RHSE we will learn about feelings, keeping clean and sun safety.
