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

ARBOR

Parent Portal & Parent App

Many parents will be aware that, from October 2023, we switched our main data system over to Arbor. The Arbor parent portal and the associated parent phone app ensure that parents can access important information about their children and, in some cases, request updates to the details we hold for you on our systems.

Reporting your child's absence from school

Same-day absences can now be reported via the app. This is straightforward: Go to your child's PROFILE then on the menu click ATTENDANCE and log the absence there. As previously, all absences <u>must be reported daily</u>. Please note: this service is for reporting absence only and should not be used for other communication. School staff will then approve or reject the absence. Once approved, it will be visible in the Attendance tab. Absence requests cannot be edited, only deleted and recreated if changes are needed, and approved absences cannot be deleted.

To activate a text dialogue – most of you will by now have received a text from us and responded which creates a unique number to message the school. If you haven't received a SMS from the school, please let us know.

PARKING

We appreciate that walking to school can be a challenge in cold, wet weather especially if you have to get to work quickly after drop-off. However, Arleston Drive is always busy and we receive regular complaints from our neighbours about people parking over their drives and from our own families where people park on the pavements. It is important that you all model courtesy and respect to our children and help ease the busyness and congestion of the daily drop-off and pick-ups.

SAFETY

Remember that we are a NUT-FREE school—this means no hazelnut spread in sandwiches, no chocolate bars or snack which contain nuts. We have lots of children and staff with nut allergies.

Dojo is a great app but it is for your use as parents only—the joining link is not to be shared with friends or wider family; this is a potential safeguarding issue.
