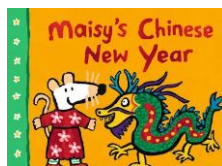
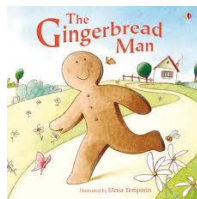
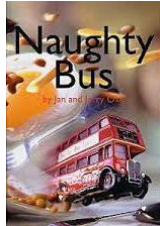

Curriculum Learning This Term

Literacy We will be using stem sentences to help us talk about the books we are reading. We will be learning key vocabulary linked to the books and using them in our sentences.

Phonics We will continue to focus on developing our speaking, listening and sound awareness skills through Phase 1 Phonics activities, this includes listening for environmental sounds, instrumental sounds, looking at body percussion and rhythm and rhyme. We will also continue to learn to read new letter sounds.


Mathematics We will continue to explore numbers to 10. We will also be looking at patterns and exploring position and space.

Personal, Social, Emotional Development We will be talking about what makes a good friend.

Physical Development We will be continuing multi skills in our outdoor PE sessions, where we are learning to use different equipment. For our Indoor PE we will be taking part in Dance.
