Curriculum Learning

Literacy- Each week we will be enjoying a different story book which will be linked to our weekly topics. We will listen to and enjoy the story, understand key words from the story and contribute to sentences based on the story.

Phonics- In the Autumn Term, we will be focusing on Phase 1. Phase 1 Phonics is designed for nursery-aged children and emphasizes on listening, speaking and sound awareness rather than learning letter sounds (which we will come to later).

Maths- In Maths, we will be focusing on developing a deeper understanding of numbers to 10, the relationships between them and the patterns within numbers. We will be using manipulatives like small objects and ten frames to organize

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counting and build a secure base of knowledge and vocabulary.

Personal, Social, Emotional Development- In PSED, we will be working on building relationships with both adult and peers, enabling children to understand their emotions, develop self-confidence and learn how to interact positively with others. We will also be learning about ourselves and our families.

Physical Development- We look forward to our outside game lessons on the Astroturf. In both dance and gymnastics, we will work towards joining different movements together to make up our own routines.

Understanding of the World- We will be learning about the season of Autumn, and looking for the different signs in our environment. We will also be learning about special events such as, Remembrance Day and Diwali. We will be taking part in Careers Week and learning about People Who Help Us. We will also be learning about Christmas and how families celebrate.

Expressive Arts and Design- This term we will be noticing colours within our environment. We will also be exploring our creative area and seeing what different things we can make.
