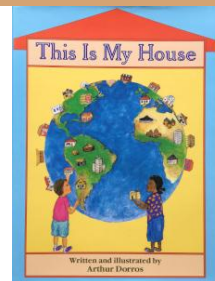
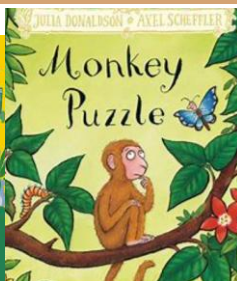
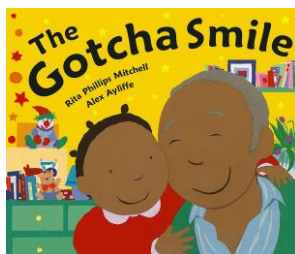

Curriculum Learning

English - In English, we are reading familiar texts and learning to identify and recall characters and parts of a story using colourful semantics. This skill supports sentence building and comprehension in reading, alongside communication.

Maths - In Maths, we are working on number and geometry this term. Counting objects and pictures and exploring shapes 2D and 3D.

Phonics - We use Little Wandle phonics scheme and this will be tailored to the level appropriate to the children, recognising sounds, or building fluency when reading.

PE - PE will have a focus on familiarizing ourselves with the outside areas and transitioning throughout school to our other playgrounds. We will also be accessing the astro for outside PE sessions with a focus on throwing and catching. During our inside PE sessions, this year, we are going to be walking to the hall and completing small obstacle courses.

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
